Wearing of Jewellery during PE and Sports Activities

The following information is taken from advice sent to us by Surrey County Council.

- In the interests of safety, the wearing of earrings is not permitted during PE lessons or sports activities.
- Ear-studs must be removed before PE lessons in accordance with Surrey County Council's Health and Safety Policy. The taping of earrings is also a possible danger and is not allowed for the same reasons. Earrings should be removed for all movement activities. This must be done by the child or the parents before coming to school on that day.
- Children will not be allowed to take part in PE lessons if they are wearing earrings of any kind.
- If parents are contemplating having their children's ears pierced this should be carried out at the beginning of the summer holidays to give the ears time to heal.
